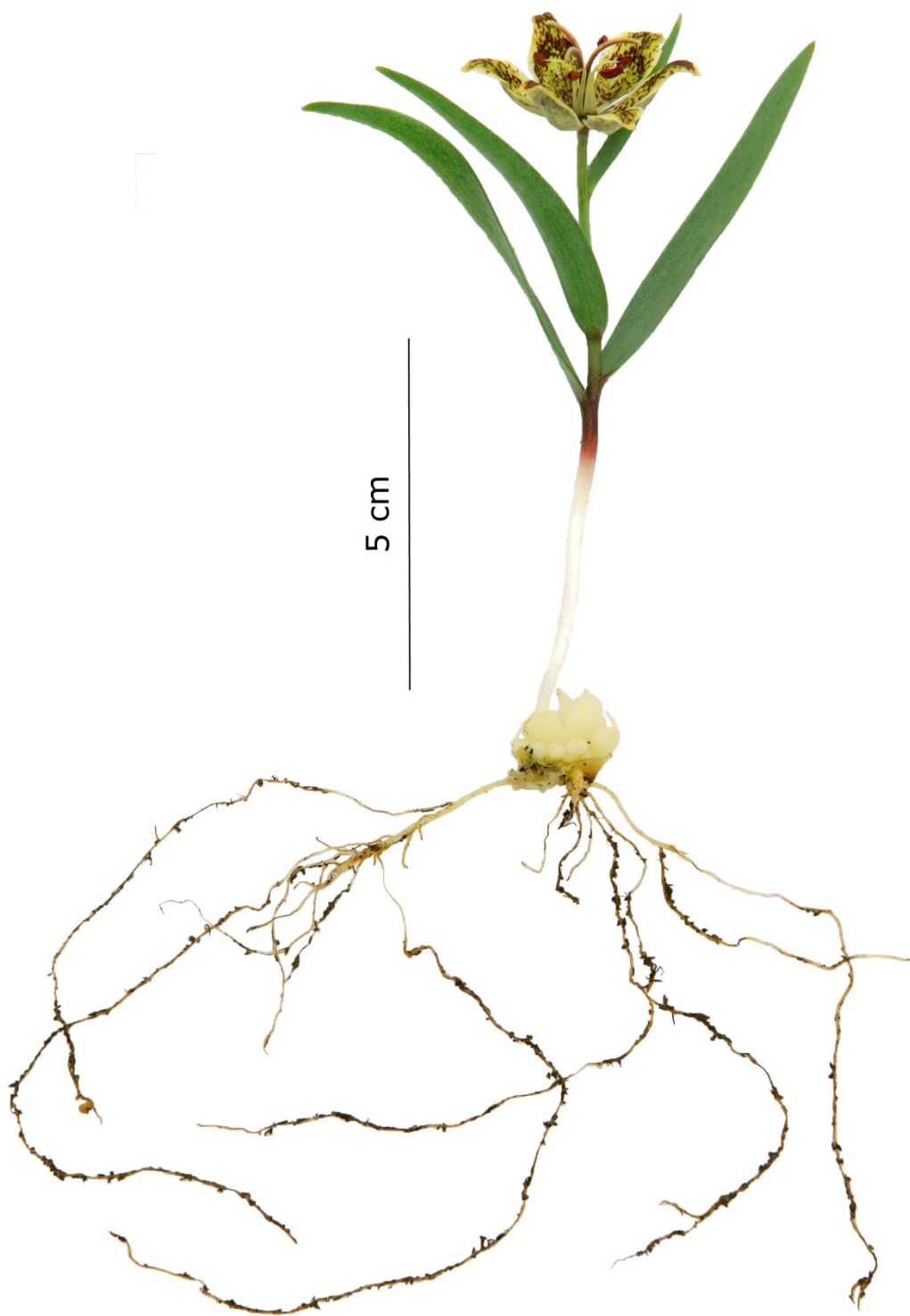

Habitat/Ecology Partially shaded, east facing, serpentine talus slopes. *Pinus coulteri* / *Calocendrus decurrens* woodland
