Habitat/Ecology Among grass on steep N-facing slope, 1980m.

Supplementary data Plant material – R Wallis & RB Wallis (2004). Jim and Jenny Archibald's Population Reference Number JJA 0.503.600. Reintroduction to their collection from the original 1964 seed cultivated by M. Tucker. Seed was only offered in the July 1991 Seed List. The plant is not typical and may have hybrid in cultivation and appears close to *F. acmopetala*. Alternatively, Zaharof [Pl. Syst. Evol. 154: 41-61 (1986)] postulated an extensive hybrid zone in Central Greece following post glacial re-colonisation.
