Collection Locality USA: California, Butte Co., Chico, Mud Creek

Habitat/Ecology South-facing at the edge of light woodland, bulbs in humus and clay at a depth 8-10 cm often sitting just below large stones, 198 m. Riparian vegetation, *Umbellularia californica*, *Quercus vislizenii*, and *Dentaria californica*, *Claytonia perfoliata*

Supplementary data Vernacular name: Checker-lily. *Fritillaria eximia* was described from this area.
