Habitat/Ecology Open coastal grassland, bulbs at a depth of 6-12cm in clay loam, plants 7-17cm above ground, single flowered, many with two and occasionally up to four.

Supplementary data Vernacular name: Chocolate-lily, mission bells

Synonym *Fritillaria kamtschatcensis* Torr. in Pacif. Rail. Rep. 4: 146 (1856, published 1857) is often incorrectly reference as a synonym of *F. biflora*.
