Collection Locality USA: California, Santa Barbara Co., South Outer Coast Ranges, San Rafael Mountains, NE of Los Olivos

Habitat/Ecology North facing open grassland with *Calystegia collina*, *Chlorogalum pomeridianum*, *Dodecathon clevelandii*, *Eschscholzia caespitosa*. Very stony serpentine-clay soil, adult bulbs positioned up to 20 cm deep just below or between large stones, juveniles with contractile roots, elevation 680 m

Supplementary data Vernacular name: Chocolate-lily, mission bells

Synonym *Fritillaria kamtschatcensis* Torr. in Pacif. Rail. Rep. 4: 146 (1856, published 1857) is often incorrectly reference as a synonym of *F. biflora*.
