

Collection Locality USA: California, Marin Co., Point Reyes Station

Habitat/Ecology Open north facing roadside verge below Cypress tree, bulbs at a depth of 3-7 cm in humus rich clay, with *Plantago* sp., *Bromus diandrus*, *Erodium* sp., elevation 37 m.

Supplementary data Scarcely mottled, black-purple forms from coastal areas of Marin Co. have been described as *Fritillaria lanceolata* Pursh var. *tristulis* A.L. Grant. Vernacular Name: Checker-lily.
